

S-Pedelects on the Inn Cycle Path

Whether S-pedelect, motorbike or moped: In addition to the classic bicycle, there are now several ways to get around on two wheels. Especially with e-bikes, it is often not clear where what is permitted. The most important information for the different types of bicycles in Germany, Austria and Switzerland is summarised here:
